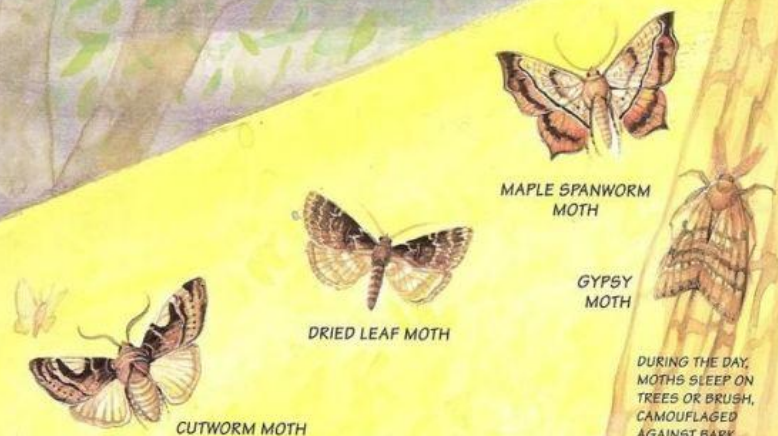


Butterflies are daytime fliers. Moths fly mostly at night.

Nobody knows exactly why night-flying moths are so strongly attracted to light, but because they are, moths are the easiest insects to locate.



AT NIGHT, BUTTERFLIES SLEEP CLINGING TO THE UNDERSIDE OF LEAVES.



Just turn on your porch light and dozens of moths will find you! You don't have to go any farther than your own doorstep.

DURING THE DAY, MOTHS SLEEP ON TREES OR BRUSH, CAMOUFLAGED AGAINST BARK.
